Elizabeth Anne Prostic

It is with heavy hearts that we record the death of Elizabeth Anne Prostic at age 31 on March 31, 2005. The cause was breast cancer. Elizabeth, who was known as Lizzie, was the daughter of Merry and Dr. Edward J. Prostic of Our Town. She graduated from The Pembroke Hill School. Lizzie was a Jewel Ball debutante in 1993. She received a bachelor of arts degree in diplomatic history and political science from The University of Pennsylvania. Lizzie was a Thurgood Marshall scholar and Moot Court Board Member at The George Washington University Law School. At the time of her death, she was a managing director at Sonnenschein, Nath & Rosenthal. She previously served as Senior Policy Advisor to the United States Secretary of Commerce and as Chief Privacy Officer for the United States Department of Commerce. What we remember best is her radiant smile in her engagement photo in 2000. She married Michael S. Lundblad on June 10, 2000, and their daughter, Harper Catherine Lundblad, was born on their fourth wedding anniversary, June 10, 2004. In addition to her parents, her husband and her daughter, Lizzie is survived by her brother and sister-in-law, Seth and Lisa Prostic; her sister, Laura Prostic; her grandmother, Vera Kaplan; her aunt and uncle, Bunni and Paul Copaken; and her aunt, Harriet Hollander.
